Favorite Recipes from Favorite Trips

Kendall College Pesto Butter

1/4 Cup Extra Virgin Olive Oil
 1/3 cup pine nuts
 1 clove garlic
 1 1/3 cups basil leaves, tightly packed, blanched, shocked and squeezed dry
 1/3 cup grated parmesan cheese

In a blender, grind oil, pine nuts & garlic together. Add basil and process until smooth. Add Parmesan cheese. Season with salt & pepper. Set aside.

1lb cream cheese, softened (very soft)
 1lb unsalted butter, softened (very soft)

Whip cream cheese in large mixer until smooth & creamy. (no lumps) then whip in softened butter. Do not over whip or this will make the finished product crumbly. Stir in pesto. Spread in a half sheet pan and chill for at least 60 minutes. Cut into circles or your desired shape(approx. 2 1/2") Dip cutter in hot water after each cut. Place on butter plates. Pesto butter scraps left in pan can be pushed together and chilled and cut again. ENJOY!!!

16oz Cream Cheese
 8oz Shredded Cheddar Cheese
 2 Tablespoons Mayo
 1 Tablespoon Garlic Salt
 1/4 cup Milk
 6-8 Green Onions - Chopped
 1 Package Cark Budding Beef - Chopped
 1/2 cup Toasted Almond Slices

Combine first 7 ingredients well. Refrigerate at least 6 hours . Immediately before serving form into your desired shape and cover with almonds. Serve with crackers or Veggies.
