Typhoons Swim Team

The Typhoons are a member of the Northern Illinois Swim Conference. The emphasis of the Conference is placed on learning competitive skills, enjoyment of the sport, and lifelong participation in swimming. The Conference focuses on dual meets and these meets are strictly for experience purposes. Practices are held weekdays Monday - Friday starting at 4:30pm. Length of practice will depend on level of swimmer. There are five dual meets and a Conference Championship Meet, all held on Wednesdays. For children who are 8 years old and younger, you must be able to swim the whole length of the pool (25 yards) without assistance. Children ages 9 and older must be able to swim 50 yards without assistance. Also, parent volunteers will be a key factor to this program. The Typhoon Swim Team needs parents to help volunteer with the concession stand, timers and scores at home swim meets. A \$30 volunteer deposit (per family) is due at the time of sign up. Only parents who volunteer at one home swim team will be refunded the volunteer deposit.

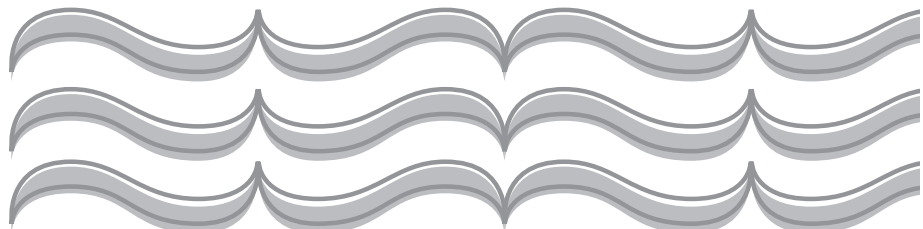
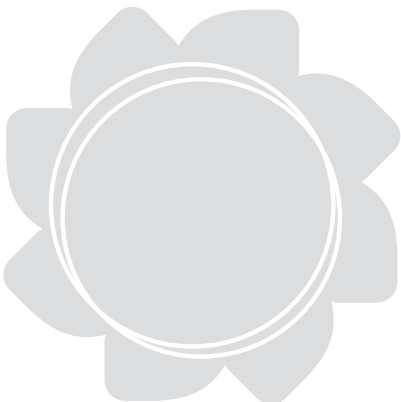

About the Staff

Our camp director and coordinators are seasoned staff members for numerous years and are currently pursuing or have completed a college degree. All of our counselors for camps with children over five years of age have graduated high school and show an aptitude towards childcare.

How to Register

1. Complete camper information sheet and liability waiver for EACH child signed and dated by parent/guardian.
2. Bring forms to the GMRC.
3. Bring a copy of your child's birth certificate & immunizations records. Copy will be kept on file at GMRC.
4. **Online registration is not available for summer camp. Forms are available online to download.**
5. If you are interested in signing your child up for camp five days a week, please register your child for both the two-day and three-day a week sessions. Exceptions will not be made to session dates and fees paid.
6. A \$10.00 fee will be charged on ALL transfers.
7. Registration deadline for all camps is Friday by Noon, prior to new session beginning.

Refund Guidelines

On or before April 23 (5 PM) full refund less 10% service fee per session.

Between April 24- June 11 (5pm) full refund less 20% service fee per session.

After June 11 - no refund.

All refund requests must be made in writing.

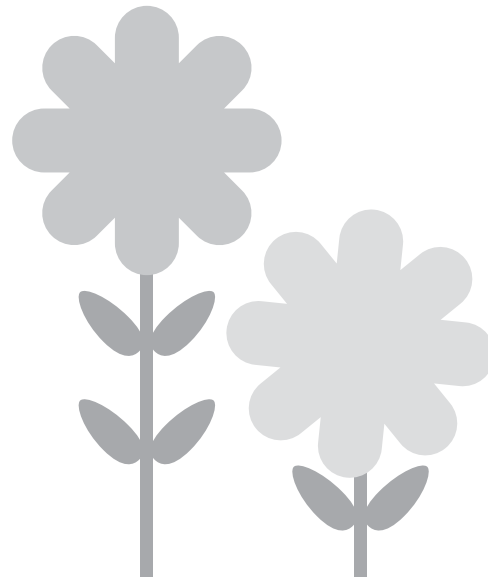
Jr. Explorers

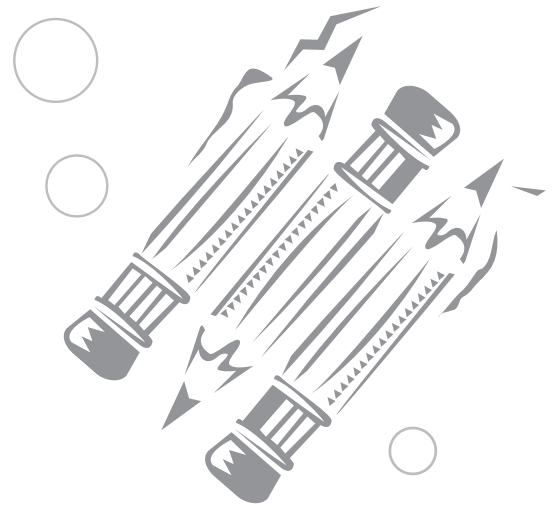

Curriculum

We use the Handwriting without Tears curriculum for writing numbers and letters. Our school incorporates the Jolly Phonics program to learn sounds. We follow the Illinois Early Learning Standard developed by the Illinois State Board of Education.

Therefore, the Prospect Heights Park District is not responsible for loss of personal property or participation in recreation programs.

Refunds and Transfers

A full refund will be issued if the registered participant is not placed in the program of choice and is placed on the waiting list.

Once a program has begun, no refunds will be made unless a medical excuse is presented.

There is a \$5 service fee if you request a refund or cancel your registration. All refunds under \$5 must be picked up at the Gary Morava Recreation Center.

There will be a \$3 service charge if you transfer out of a program.

No refunds, not even medical, are given for deposits, passes, trips or even special events before or after the event, unless canceled by the park district.

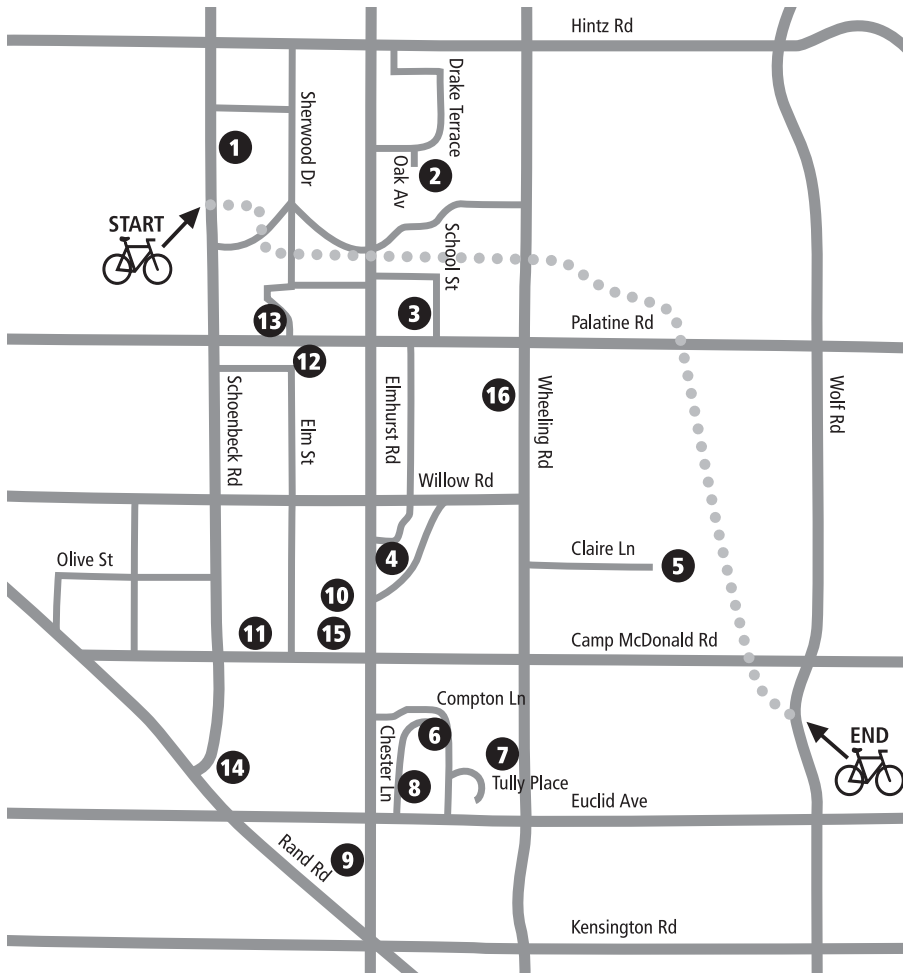
